Supported Child Development Assistants (casual & part time)

Location

Assistants may work in preschools, full day group child care, after school programs, or in some cases in the child's home.

Position

The Supported Child Development (SCDP) Assistants are required to work independently and within a child care team, to provide a stimulating and nurturing environment while working on goals outlined in the child's/children's Individual Service Plan. Successful candidates will demonstrate a commitment to the principles of inclusion and early childhood development. Assistants must be flexible and available during the daytime hours as well as after school.

Qualifications

SCDP Assistants will have relevant education (ECE, CEA or other) and experience working with children who have support needs. Knowledge of child care licensing and best practices in child care is recommended.
